Valspar picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including 2 wins.

Jon Rahm – Rahm has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played and he is on a trend coming into Valspar.

Jason Day – Day has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Jim Furyk – Furyk has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Furyk finished 7th at this event last year.

Lucas Glover – Glover has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Glover finishes 18th at this tourney in 2017.

Gary Woodland – Woodland has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Woodland has an 8th place finish at Valspar in 2014.

Jason Kokrak – Kokrak has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Kokrak finished 8^{th} at Valspar last year and he finished 7^{th} in 2015.

Sergio Garcia – Garcia has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Garcia finished 4th at this event last year.

J.T. Poston – Poston is on a trend coming into this tourney with 5 straight cuts made and 3 top 30 finishes in those 5 most recent events played. Poston finished 14th at this tourney in 2017.

Ryan Moore – Moore is on a trend coming into Valspar with a 20th finish at The Players last week. Moore has 2 top 5 finishes at this event over the past 4 years.
