WGC Mexico picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Jon Rahm – Rahm has 5 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Rahm finished 20th at WGC Mexico last year and he finished 3rd in 2017.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy has 3 top 5 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. McIlroy finished 7th at this event in 2017.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler has 3 top 5 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win in his most recent event. Fowler finished 30th at this tourney last year and 16th in 2017.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson is on a trend coming into this event to go with 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Johnson finished 7th last year and he won this event in 2017.

Justin Thomas – Thomas has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played (3 top 3s). Thomas finished 2nd at WGC Mexico last year and he finished 5th in 2017.

Bryson DeChambeau – DeChambeau has 5 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. This is DeChambeau's debut at WGC Mexico.

Tiger Woods – Woods has 5 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. This is Woods' debut at WGC Mexico.

Marc Leishman – Leishman has 4 top 5 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Leishman finished 37th at this event last year.

Phil Mickelson – Mickelson has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Mickelson is the defending champion.

Webb Simpson – Simpson has 5 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.
