Jon Rahm – Rahm has 5 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Rahm has 3 top 20 finishes at Waste Mgt over the past 4 years (3 played).

Matt Kuchar – Kuchar has 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including 2 wins. Kuchar finished 5th at this event last year and he finished 9th in 2017.

Webb Simpson – Simpson has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played (also 15th). Simpson finished 2nd here in 2017, 14th in 2016.

Hideki Matsuyama – Matsuyama is on a trend coming into Waste Mgt with a 3rd finish in his most recent event played. Matsuyama won this event in 2016 and 2017 with a 2nd in 2015 and a 4th in 2014.

Xander Schauffele – Schauffele has 5 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including 2 wins. Schauffele finished 17th at Waste Mgt last year.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Fowler finished 11th last year at this event, 4th in 2017, 2nd in 2016.

Gary Woodland – Woodland has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Woodland is the defending champion.

Tony Finau – Finau has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Phil Mickelson – Mickelson is on a trend coming into this event to go along with a 2nd finish last year at Waste Mgt.

Justin Thomas – Thomas has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Thomas finished 17th at this event last year.
