Punta Cana picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Will Zalatoris – Zalatoris has 5 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, 3 top 10s, including a 6^{th} finish at the U.S. Open last week.

Sam Burns – Burns is on a trend with a 7th finish in his most recent event played. Last year Burns finished 12th at Punta Cana.

MacKenzie Hughes – Hughes has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, 2 top 10s. Hughes finished 2nd at this event last year.

Emiliano Grillo – Grillo is trending coming into this event with a top 30 in his most recent event played, to go with 2 top 10s in his most recent 5 events played.

Kristoffer Ventura – Ventura has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played and he is on a trend coming into this tourney with a 7th finish in his most recent start.

Thomas Detry – Detry has 2 second place finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Detry finished 33rd at Punta Cana last year.

Graeme McDowell – McDowell is the defending champion.

Beau Hossler – Hossler has 2 top 25 finishes in his most recent 4 events played and he is on a trend coming into this tourney.

Adam Long – Long is on a trend coming into Punta Cana with a 13th finish in his most recent event played. Long is also one of a handful of players who hasn't missed a cut in his 5 most recent events played.

Henrik Stenson – Stenson, along with McDowell are the only major winners in the field.
