RSM picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Webb Simpson – Simpson has 5 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Simpson finished 2^{nd} at this event last year and he finished 3^{rd} in 2018.

Joaquin Niemann – Niemann has 3 top 25 finishes in his most recent 4 events played.

Tyrrell Hatton – Hatton has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win.

Corey Conners – Conners is trending coming into RSM with a 10th at the Masters last week. Conners also has 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Conners finished 23rd at RSM in 2018.

MacKenzie Hughes – Hughes is trending coming into this tourney with a 7th finish in his most recent event played. He's 2 top 10s in his most recent 4 events played and Hughes won here in 2016.

Sungjae Im – Im has 2 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a 2nd at the Masters last week. Im finished 37th at RSM in 2018.

Talor Gooch – Gooch has 2 top 5 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Gooch finished 23rd at this tourney last year.

Tommy Fleetwood – Fleetwood is trending coming into this event with a 19th finish at Augusta last week.

Sebastian Munoz – Munoz has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Munoz finished 3rd at RSM last year.

Russell Henley – Henley has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Henley also has 2 top 10 finishes at this event over the past 5 years (2015 and 2016).
