Tour Championship 2020 Picks

Tour Championship picks are based on the Fedex Cup standings. Others to consider are the rest of the field.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson is number 1 and starts the Tour Championship at 10 under par. (A 2-shot lead). 3 top 10 finishes at the Tour Championship over the past 5 years.

Jon Rahm – Rahm starts the tourney at -8, 2 shots back. Rahm has 3 top 15 finishes at East Lake over the past 3 years.

Justin Thomas – Thomas starts the event at -7. Thomas has 4 top 10 finishes at this tourney over the past 4 years.

Webb Simpson – Simpson didn't play at the BMW, but he's still at the number 4 spot and starts the event 4 shots off the lead. Simpson has 1 top 10 finish at East Lake over the past 3 years.

Collin Morikawa – Morikawa has the 5th spot going into the Tour Championship and starts at -5. This is Morikawa's Tour Championship debut.

Daniel Berger – Berger shares the 6th spot with the remaining 4 players and all start at 4 under par, 6 shots from the lead. Berger posted 3 top 15 finishes in years 2015-2017.

Harris English – English occupies the same spot at Berger. English finished 22nd at this event in 2015.

Bryson DeChambeau – DeChambeau is tied with Berger and English for 6th place going into the tourney. DeChambeau finished 7th at this event last year and he finished 19th in 2018.

Sungjae Im – Im starts the event with the above 3 players at 6th position. Im finished 15th in his first go at this tourney last year.

Hideki Matsuyama – Matsuyama is the final player at 6th place and starts at -4 with the Berger, English, DeChambeau and Im. Matsuyama has 2 top 10 finishes over the past 4 years at this tourney.
