

Bermuda 2021 Picks

Bermuda picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Christiaan Bezuidenhout – Bezuidenhout has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, 3 top 10s, which includes 2 top 5 finishes in his most recent 2 events played.

Sahith Theegala – Theegala has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Seamus Power – Power has 2 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Power has 2 finishes in the 30s in the past 2 years at Bermuda.

Matt Fitzpatrick – Fitzpatrick has 2 top 20 finishes in his most recent 2 events played, including a win.

Hayden Buckley – Buckley has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, 2 top 10s in his most recent 2 events played.

Adam Hadwin – Hadwin is trending coming into this tourney with a 6th finish in his most recent event played, the 6th is part of 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Jason Dufner – Dufner has 4 top 30 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Dufner finished 58th at Bermuda last year.

Danny Willett – Willett has 2 top 25 finishes in his most recent 2 events played, including a win. Willett finished 55th at this tourney last year.

Patrick Reed – Reed has 3 top 35 finishes in his most recent 5 events played and he is on a slight trend coming into this event.

Russell Knox – Knox has 2 top 30 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Knox finished 16th at Bermuda last year and he finished 11th in 2019.
