Hero 2021 Picks

Hero picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Justin Thomas – Thomas has 3 top 5 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Thomas finished 5th at Hero in 2019 and he finished 12th in 2018 and 11th in 2017.

Collin Morikawa – Morikawa has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played, including a win in his most recent event played. This is his first Hero start.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, 3 top 10s in that span and a win.

Justin Rose – Rose is trending coming into Hero with a 12th finish in his most recent event played. Rose has 3 top 5 finishes in his 3 most recent starts at this event.

Sam Burns – Burns has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win.

Daniel Berger – Berger has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played and he is trending coming into this tourney. Berger finished 14th in his last start at this tourney in 2017.

Patrick Reed – Reed is trending coming into this event with a 32nd place finish in his most recent event played. Reed has 3 top 10 finishes in his last 4 starts at Hero.

Matt Fitzpatrick – Fitzpatrick has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win and a second finish.

Bryson DeChambeau – DeChambeau has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. DeChambeau has 2 top 15 finishes at Hero over the past 3 years. (2 starts.)

Henrik Stenson – Stenson has 3 top 30 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Stenson is the defending champion and he's 2 other top 5 finishes over the past 5 years.
