Sentry 2021 Picks

Sentry picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Justin Thomas – Thomas has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played and 2 12th finishes. Thomas has 2 wins at Sentry over the past 4 years.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson has 4 top 3 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Johnson has 5 top 10 finishes at this tourney over the past 5 years, also including a win.

Xander Schauffele – Schauffele has 5 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win and 2 top 5s. Schauffele finished second at this event last year and he won in 2019.

Jon Rahm – Rahm has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Rahm finished top 10 at Sentry in each of the past 3 years.

Patrick Reed – Reed has 5 top 15 finishes in his most recent events played, 3 top 10s. Reed has 3 top 10 finishes at this tourney over the past 5 years.

Hideki Matsuyama – Matsuyama has 2 top 15 finishes in his most recent 2 events played. Matsuyama has 2 top 5 finishes at this event over the past 4 years.

Harris English – English has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. English has no starts at Sentry over the past 5 years.

Patrick Cantlay – Cantlay has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win. Cantlay finished 4th at this event last year and 15th in 2018.

Bryson DeChambeau – DeChambeau has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played, including a win. DeChambeau finished 7th at this tourney in 2019.

Collin Morikawa – Morikawa is trending coming into this event with a 10th finish in his most recent event played. Morikawa finished 7th in his debut at Sentry last year.
