Sam Burns – Burns has 5 top 30 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Burns finished 7th at this event last year and he finished 7th in 2020.

Aaron Wise – Wise has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Wise finished 26th at this tourney last year and he finished 11th in 2020.

Maverick McNealy – McNealy has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. McNealy has 3 top 20 finishes at this event over the past 3 years.

Davis Riley – Riley is on a trend coming into Houston with a 21st finish in his most recent event played. Riley finished 29th at this tourney last year.
