Patrick Cantlay – Cantlay has a second-place finish in his 2 most recent events played. Cantlay is the defending champion to go with a win in 2019 and a 4th in 2018.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. McIlroy has 2 top 20 finishes at this event over the past 4 years.

Cameron Young – Young has 3 top 3 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. First Memorial start.

Jordan Spieth – Spieth has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Spieth has 4 top 20 finishes at this tourney over the past 5 years.

Patrick Reed – Reed is trending coming into Memorial with a 7th finish in his most recent event played. Reed finished 5th last year at Memorial and he finished 10th in 2020.

Shane Lowry – Lowry has 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Lowry finished 6th at this event last year.

Matt Fitzpatrick – Fitzpatrick has 2 top 5 finishes in his most recent 2 events played. Fitzpatrick finished 3rd at this tourney in 2020.

Max Homa – Homa has 3 top 25 finishes in his most recent 3 events played, including a win. Homa finished 6th at Memorial last year.

Mito Pereira — Pereira has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. First Memorial start.
