RSM picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Tony Finau – Finau has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win in his most recent event played.

Taylor Montgomery – Montgomery has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Tom Hoge – Hoge has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Hoge finished 4th at RSM last year.

Joel Dahmen – Dahmen has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played (2 top 10s in his most recent 2 events).

Matthew NeSmith – NeSmith has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. NeSmith has 2 top 15 finishes at this tourney over the past 3 years.

Brian Harman – Harman has 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Harman has 2 top 15 finishes at this event over the past 5 years.

Seamus Power – Power has 2 top 3 finishes in his most recent 2 events played, including a win. Power finished 4th at RSM last year.

MacKenzie Hughes – Hughes has 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Hughes finished 2^{nd} at this event last year.

Patrick Rodgers – Rodgers has 5 top 30 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Rodgers finished 2nd at this tourney in 2018.

Patton Kizzire – Kizzire is trending coming into this event with a 10th finish in his most recent event played. Kizzire finished 10th at RSM in 2020 and he finished 15th in 2018.
