Sentry picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Justin Thomas – Thomas has 3 top 5 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Thomas has 4 top 3 finishes at Sentry over the past 5 years, including 2 wins.

Collin Morikawa – Morikawa has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win and a second. Morikawa has finished 7th in each of the past 2 years at this event.

Xander Schauffele – Schauffele has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Schauffele has 3 top 5 finishes at this tourney over the past 3 years, including a win.

Bryson DeChambeau – DeChambeau has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. DeChambeau has 2 top 10 finishes at Sentry over the past 3 years.

Sam Burns – Burns has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. This is Burns first Sentry start.

Viktor Hovland – Hovland has 2 wins in his most recent 2 events played. Hovland finished 31st last year in his first start at this event.

Daniel Berger – Berger has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played and he is on a trend coming into this tourney. Berger has 3 top 15 finishes at Sentry over the past 5 years.

Sungjae Im – Im has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 3 events played, including a win. Im finished 5th at this tourney last year.

Patrick Cantlay – Cantlay has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 3 events played, including a win. Cantlay has 3 top 15 finishes at Sentry over the past 4 years.
