Shriners picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Patrick Cantlay – Cantlay has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Cantlay won Shriners' in 2017, he was 2nd in 2018 and '19, 8th in 2020.

Sungjae Im – Im has 5 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including 3 runner up finishes. Im is the defending champion.

Taylor Montgomery – Montgomery has 5 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Max Homa – Homa has 2 top 3 finishes in his most recent 2 events played, including a win.

Aaron Wise – Wise has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Wise finished 8th at Shriners last year.

Tom Hoge – Hoge has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Hoge has 3 top 25 finishes at this event over the past 5 years.

Thomas Detry – Detry has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 3 events played, 2 top 10s.

Joohyung (Tom) Kim – Kim has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win.

Emiliano Grillo – Grillo has 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Matthew NeSmith – NeSmith is on a trend coming into this event with a 24th finish in his most recent event played. NeSmith finished 14th at Shriners last year, 8th in 2020 and 18th in 2019.
