Tony Finau – Finau has 3 top 5 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including 2 wins. Finau has 4 top 15 finishes at East Lake over the past 5 years.

Patrick Cantlay – Cantlay has 3 top 5 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win at BMW on Sunday. Cantlay finished 4th at this event last year.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. McIlroy has 3 top 10s at this tourney over the past 4 years, including a win in 2019.

Jon Rahm – Rahm has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 2 events played. Rahm is the defending champion to go along with 2 other top 10 finishes at East Lake.

Justin Thomas – Thomas has 1 top 15 finish in his most recent 2 events played, he finished 52nd at BMW. Thomas has 3 top 5 finishes at this event over the past 5 years.

Scott Stallings – Stallings has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Sungjae Im – Im has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Im has 2 top 15 finishes at this tourney over the past 3 years.

Scottie Scheffler – Scheffler finished 3rd at BMW this week and he finished 2nd at East Lake in 2020.

Adam Scott – Scott has 2 top 5 finishes in his most recent 2 events played. Scott finished 5th at this event in 2019.
