Viktor Hovland – Hovland has 4 top 5 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including 3 wins.

Jon Rahm – Rahm has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Rahm has 4 top 15 finishes over the last 4 years at this event.

Patrick Cantlay – Cantlay has 5 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Justin Thomas – Thomas has 5 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Thomas has 4 top 20 finishes at Waste Mgt over the past 4 years.

Hideki Matsuyama – Matsuyama has 3 top 15 finishes over his most recent 4 events played, including 2 wins. Matsuyama won this event in 2017 and he posted 15th in 2019 and he was 16th in 2020.

Jordan Spieth – Spieth has 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played and he is on a trend coming into this event with a 2nd last week at Pebble. Spieth has 2 top 10s at this event over the past 5 years.
